PROVISIONAL ANNOTATED AGENDA

The Sixty-third Session of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC-63) will take place from 27 to 30 October 2025 at the ESAN Convention Center, Jr. Alonso de Molina 1652, Santiago de Surco, Lima, Peru.

The session documents will not be distributed on paper but will be posted on a dedicated web page at <https://www.ipcc.ch/meeting-doc/ipcc-63/>. In addition, the IPCC Papersmart system will allow registered participants to access session documents in electronic format during the meeting on a dedicated web portal using individual credentials linked to their registration. Participants are encouraged to download the documentation on their computers in advance of the session.

Simultaneous interpretation in Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish will be provided during the plenary Session. All documentation will be in English only.
