The OCE works in all regions of the world, with a particular focus on developing countries.

In France, the Office is developing educational resources to support the introduction of climate change into high school curricula. OCE also supports primary and secondary school teachers with resources and training.

This event will be an opportunity to present the missions and the European network of the OCE, the resources produced and the pilot project in Latin America.
