Outreach event on IPCC activities and findings, Havana, Cuba 26 January 2023

Information for participants

Introduction

The outreach events on IPCC activities and findings will take place at the Havana International Convention Center, on 26 January 2023. The main objective of the event will be presenting the key findings from the three recently released contributions to the IPCC Sixth Assessment Report on the Physical Science Basis, on Impacts, Adaptation and Vulnerability, and on Mitigation of Climate Change. IPCC Lead Authors and officials will also participate in additional outreach activities on 27 January outside the Conference venue: event with national journalists and event with economists, social scientists and university students.

How to get there?

The most common way is to take a flight to Havana airport. Transportation services can be available to pick-up participants, particularly those who chose the Accommodation Packages for Participants included in this Note, which the Organizing Committee strongly recommends (see Annexes I & II).

Accommodation and meals

The PALCO Hotel**** is the venue hotel to all congresses & events held at the Convention Center. Guests will enjoy comfortable rooms, as well as facilities & services surrounded by a pleasant and quiet ambience. Participants can access the conference halls in minutes via a walking tunnel with a number of shops and various other facilities to the visitor. Lunch facilities are available at the venue at the expenses of the participants. Accommodation and meals are also available at the Palco Hotel, right next to the venue, also at the expenses of the participants (see Annex I). In addition to Palco Hotel, participants can also consider the accommodation options offered by AMISTUR Cuba in Hotel Copacabana*** and Hotel El Viejo y el Mar**** (see Annex II).

It is highly recommended for all delegates to book the Palco hotel due to its close proximity to the venue; or to book the accommodation options offered by Amistur Cuba, which include transfers to the venue and back to the hotel on 26 January, and transfers to the IPCC side-events and back to the hotel on 27 January.

Visa

It is the responsibility of participants themselves to check visa requirements applicable to their country. If you require a visa and have not informed us about this yet, please do so as soon as possible. Participants supported by IPCC who need a visa to enter Cuba are required to provide the Local Organizing Committee (<u>rpichs@yahoo.com.mx</u> / <u>psicologoken@gmail.com</u>) the following information as soon as possible:

- Passport Number
- Place and day of birth
- Nationalities
- Country of residence
- Institutional Affiliation
- Copy of the main page of passport to be used (photo page)

The organizers will provide the above information to the Foreign Affairs Ministry to facilitate the visa application processes at the corresponding Cuban embassies.

Registration at the venue

There will be a registration desk where participants can register and collect badges.

3 - COVID-19-related regulations and other health issues

COVID-19:

Participants are no longer required to show proof of vaccination to enter Cuba. However, rules and regulations regarding COVID-19 may change at short notice and we will keep you informed in case of changes. The Local Organizing Committee will do their best to assist participants but cannot be held accountable for unforeseen restrictions and last-minute changes.

Where applicable, we ask all the participants to adhere to the rules and regulations regarding COVID-19. We recommend that you bring several facemasks with you; and take a self-test prior to the event. Neither the organizers nor the venue can be held accountable for exposure to COVID-19 or any consequences thereof. Extra costs associated with quarantine and extended stay will not be covered by the hosts and organizers.

Vaccinations / health insurance

- Participants are responsible for checking the vaccination requirements for Cuba.
- Participants are responsible for obtaining comprehensive international travel and health insurance for the duration of their stay. The Local Organizing Committee and hosts disclaim all responsibility for medical, accident and travel insurance, for compensation for death or disability, for loss or damage to personal property and for any other costs or losses that may incur during travel or participation in the event.

4. Electricity

The voltage in Cuba is generally 110 volts, even though in some outlets you may get 220 volts, and they will be signed as such.

Two prongs thin plug is the one mostly used in Cuba. Power plugs and sockets are of type A, B and C.



5. Weather

During January in Havana, Cuba, the temperature ranges from high 26.4°C (79.5°F) to minimum 18.8°C (65.8°F). Monthly precipitation in January, in Havana, averages 70.2 mm.

6. Currency

The currency used in Cuba is Cuban Peso (CUP).

You can bring many types of currency to the island and exchange it for pesos once you arrive (see, for reference: <u>www.bc.gob.cu</u>), however most of your payments during the event will be requested by credit cards or national pre-paid cards as indicated below. If you decide to change a foreign currency to Cuban pesos, be aware that it is not possible to change that amount back into any hard currency. CADECA (money exchange locations) accepts many types of currency. The Euro is still considered to be the currency of choice to bring to Cuba. It is practical, convenient and widely accepted. Despite the Cuban peso being the only official currency in Cuba, there are stores that sell products like groceries, appliances, and other home goods that can be purchased by <u>using prepaid credit ca</u>rds (only VISA and Mastercard) <u>issued by non-US banks</u>.

Travelers and tourists who visit Cuba and have credit or debit cards that are not accepted in Cuban businesses (e.g., those issued by US banks), may buy a prepaid card (tarjeta prepago) in the national territory. This will be valid for the payment of goods and services in the commercial network in freely convertible currency (MLC, in Spanish).

Requirements to obtain the prepaid card:

- Identification document: foreign passport
- Cash amount equivalent to 5 USD to buy the card
- Amount in cash (in hard currencies except for the USD, such as euros, CHF, GBP, and others) for the equivalent value of 1000 USD, 500 USD or 200 USD to recharge the prepaid card. Values in USD used here are only referential, as cash in USD is not accepted for recharging the prepaid cards.

Places to obtain the prepaid card:

- The Credit and Commerce Bank (BANDEC) with branches throughout the national territory
- The Exchange Houses (CADECA) located at airports, tourist poles and in networks distributed throughout the national territory
